- 753 BC Rome is founded by Romulus
- 509 BC Tarquin is expelled, and the Republic is founded
- 264 -241 BC - First Punic War, Rome destroys Carthage
- 44 BC - Caesar is assassinated on March 15
- 27 BC Augustus (Octavian) becomes emperor
- 476 AD The last western emperor is deposed, Rome falls.

Your timeline should include at least 10 events in the correct order from Roman history, have a proper scale (ex. 100 years = 1 inch), a title describing the place and time period you are covering, and have a brief description (one or two sentences) describing the events. You may wish to add pictures to add to the presentation of your timeline. Also, you must include a separate reference sheet notating where your information came from (see Reference sheet for format).
